Father will be away April 28-May 2 – no weekday masses during this time.


May 3, 5:00 Archbishop Legatt will be joining us to celebrate Mass and confirm our youth. This will be followed by a pot luck in the hall.

*Carlo Acutis, do you know who he is?

This young Italian (1991-2006) was considered a "computer geek" but his passion was for God and the Eucharist. He used his computer skills and internet savvy to develop a website exhibition on Eucharistic miracles hoping that it would help people to realize that Jesus is really present in the Eucharist and come back to Mass. Look up:

Carlo Acutis 'Eucharistic Miracles' Exhibition.

At the age of 15 (2006) Carlo died of acute leukemia. The call for Acutis to be beatified began not long after his death. Carlo Acutis will be canonized a 'Saint' in Rome, by Pope Francis, during the Jubilee of Teenagers from April 25–27, 2025.

From September 16 to 29, 2025, Mrs.
Normandeau will be in our diocese of
St. Boniface to present: "The
International Exhibition of Eucharistic
Miracles", created by Blessed Carlo
Acutis who will have been canonized a
'Saint' by the time he visits our diocese.
She also brings with her, a 1st class relic
of Carlo.

*Mrs. Normandeau will give a presentation of the Exhibition to our English Parishes. Place, date and time to be determined. She will present in French and translation to English will be provided. There will be a time for Veneration of the relic. Various pamphlets, books, bookmarks, holy images & medals will be available for free or for purchase.
