Recap of last minutes meeting: Rummage sale total \$6630 out of that \$625 youth raised. A fire pit was purchased by the youth with the help of the ladies aux.

Everything is in place for the church picnic except we need to find pricing for ordering cup cakes, which Corinne and Claire will do.

Pilgrimage campout: everything is set we just need some volunteers to help out for the weekend.

Other Discussion: Financial report – There is insufficient funds to pay the bills. We were able to pay the \$14,000 propane bill that was owing with the money from the parish rainy day account along with other donations. But we are still short \$21,000 for insurance. Propane and heat are \$12,500 to \$15,000 a year. So they are looking into switching over to electric heat which would be a substantial savings.

Some members of the financial committee suggested that we only have a priest on certain Sundays which they say would save us money and keep our church running, and there was also other proposals brought forward. It was suggested that these proposals should be put together and shared with our parishioner's so our parish would know what was happing and decide together what we can do about our situation.
